

ONE OF A KIND 1936 Rearwin Speedster 6000C

RECENTLY REDUCED to \$75,000

Rearwin Airplanes was founded by Raymond Andrew ("Rae") Rearwin in 1928. Employing his two sons, Royce and Ken, Rae's small company designed and built over 400 airplanes, including instrument trainers and gliders.

Eighty-three years later Rae's greatgrand son, Eric Rearwin, has brought this Speedster back to museum quality condition with the expert restoration skills of Tim Talen of Ragwood Refactory in Springfield, Or.

This airplane (serial number 302) was the prototype for the 14 Speedsters to follow and is the only example in existence with the Cirrus Hi-drive engine.
